African-American Program Kit

GSUSA Asthma Awareness Patch Program Kit

(All Grade Levels)

Girl hand-outs and activities are in both English and Spanish.

High on Life Badge Program Kit
(Girl Scout Juniors)

Use hands-on activities to learn about the realities and the dangers of drug and alcohol use. Explore how use or experimentation may interfere with personal goals and become more aware of what to look out for. This kit combines a Hazelden curriculum with activities, ready to use materials and leader resources.

Masters of Disaster Program Kit
(Girl Scout Brownies)

This Red Cross curriculum contains various activities for learning to be prepared for natural disasters, including: hurricanes, floods, tornadoes, and earthquakes. Use this, single or multi-day, curriculum to help girls understand natural disasters that may happen in Minnesota, and other parts of the world. Odd Girl Out Program Kit

Program Kits - OTTERS (Outdoor Tips and Tricks for Environmental Resource Stewardship) Kits contain fun and easy outdoor and nature activities; Use any OTTERS kit to earn the OTTERS Base Patch, available in the council shop. Girls can earn add-on fish patches for every additional kit completed.

OTTERS: Adventures After Dark (Girl Scout Brownies through Girl Scout Ambassadors)

Includes games and activities about nocturnal animals, constellations and the night sky, campfires, storytelling, and night vision. Kit includes both outdoor and indoor activities.

OTTERS: Birds

(Girl Scout Brownies and Girl Scout Juniors)

Girls discover the characteristics of birds, and why birds have different types of beaks, nests, and food. The activities can be done either inside or outside.

OTTERS: Buggin' Out

(Girl Scout Brownies and Girl Scout Juniors)

Activities about insects including scavenger hunts, inventing insects, and observing insects. Most of the activities can be done inside.

OTTERS: Cooperative Games

(All Grade Levels)

Work together and think creatively with games that focus on fun for all instead of winners and losers. The activities can be done either outside or in an open space inside.

OTTERS: Introduction to Nature

(All Grade Levels)

Mix of quiet and active activities involving camouflage, animal recognition, predator/prey, and trivia games. Activities can be done either inside or outside.

OTTERS: Mammal Mania and Wolf Tracks

(Girl Scout Juniors through Girl Scout Cadettes)

Learn about mammals through hands-on games that can be played indoors or outdoors. Or explore the habits and characteristics of wolves. Activities include making masks, reading stories, mapping wolf ranges and playing games.

OTTERS: Nature Awareness

(All Grade Levels)

Use your senses of sight, touch, and smell in the out-of-doors. Best for hikes or backyard exploring, and includes creative writing activities.

OTTERS: Talkin' Trash

(Girl Scout Juniors through Girl Scout Seniors)

Learn how composting and recycling work, survey trash and household hazardous waste, make recycled paper and household cleaners, and demonstrate the effects of pollution. Most activities can be done indoors.

OTTERS: Trees

(Girl Scout Brownies and Girl Scout Juniors)

Learn how to tell the age of a tree and its life story, what it needs to survive, what may live in the tree, and write a poem about what you've learned. Some activities need to be done outside.

OTTERS: Wildlife Wonders

(Girl Scout Daisy and Girl Scout Brownies)

Investigate a variety of wildlife such as birds, moles, and other critters with active games and craft projects. Activities can be done inside. Some require a large play area.

OTTERS: Winter Explorers

(Girl Scout Brownies through Girl Scout Cadettes)

Find animal tracks, learn about adaptations to cold and snow, and identify winter plants and weather patterns through games and experiments. Includes some indoor activities, but most are meant to be outside.
