### **WHAT IS THE DRESS CODE?**

Delegates should wear the official Girl scout uniform for the appropriate age level (girl member, adult).

- Delegates who are girl members wear solid white shirts and khaki pants or skirts with their official uniform item (e.g., tunic, vest, sash) for the display of official pins and awards.
- Delegates who are adult members wear navy blue business attire. Women wear an official scarf with the membership pins, and men wear the official tie with the membership pins.
