



Outdoor Cooking Equipment Locations and Availability

Outdoor Cooking equipment is located in a centralized area at each site. Groups take what they need. Bins will be available to carry the equipment to the site needed. Bins can be left at the site after use and staff will pick up, sanitize and return to storage area.

- Elk River: Timbermeade basement
- Lakamaga: Basement of Mary Randall (please enter through the lower back door)
- Northwoods Davidson Troop House Basement
- Singing Hills: Side room of Dining Hall
- Whispering Hills Back Room of Dining Hall

All equipment must be used on site.
