

What Is Day Camp?

Girl Scout day camp provides a safe and fun environment where girls can explore the great outdoors. Our girls are placed in program units of 12 other girls their age. Activities include singing, games, cooking outdoors, swimming, exploring nature, arts and crafts and outdoor camping (one night). Jr. Girl Scouts will have the opportunity to try archery.

Who Can Go To Day Camp?

All girls entering grades 1-6 (Fall 2008) are welcome to attend. Day camp is open to all girls regardless of race, religion, ethnicity, ability or socio-economic status.

How Much Does Camp Cost?

Camp fees for 2008 are \$120.00. Please make checks payable to "Northern Lights Day Camp" and send payment with your registration. Each full time TRAINED volunteer receives one free camper registration. Each full-time UNTRAINED volunteer receives 50% off the registration fee. Grants are available, contact us for further information.

Do I Have To Be A Registered Girl Scout To Attend Camp?

Yes! Girls who are not currently registered Girl Scouts, can become members when they register for camp by enclosing the membership fee of \$10.00 payable to GSMWRV.

How Do I Get To Camp?

Can I Come To Camp With A Friend?

Yes! Two friends may register together as "buddies" and will be placed in a unit together for the week. One pair only, please!! Send both registrations and payments together in the same envelope. For safety reasons, the pair will be placed in a unit appropriate for the youngest girl in the buddy pair.

Who Will Be My Camp Counselors?

Day camp is organized, staffed and led entirely by VOLUNTEERS. Each unit of approximately 12 girls is led by TWO GIRL SCOUT TRAINED volunteers and at least one other VOLUNTEER adult. In addition, trained Caddies (Girl Scouts in grades 7-12) work with each unit to assist with the camp program and serve as role models for the girls.



What About Health and Safety?

Health and safety awareness is a part of staff training and camp orientation. We will follow the guidelines provided by Girl Scouts of USA, as well as state and local health codes. First aid staff is on site at all times.

How Do I Sign Up?

Registration begins immediately and remain open until camp is full or May 15th. Send registrations to Northern Lights Day Camp, P.O. Box 9085, No. St. Paul, MN 55109-9085. **PLEASE SEND YOUR REGISTRATION EARLY AS CAMP WILL BE FILLED ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS.**

Will I Get More Information About Day Camp Before It Starts?

Yes! After you register, you will receive a confirmation and health history or notice that you are on the wait list. Additional information; what to bring to camp and the bus schedule will be mailed out in mid June.

What If I Have To Cancel?

If you need to cancel due to injury or family emergency, it must be submitted in writing as soon as possible.
