

Forms We Need From You BEFORE Camp

1. Health History Form – all campers must have

- The Health History section of the form must be completed within the six months prior to your camper attending camp.
- If your child has special needs that the camp staff should be aware of, please contact the camp director at least six weeks prior to her camp session.

Please send to the Brooklyn Center Service Center four weeks prior to camp session (except Camp Northwoods – Health History Form must be in hand to get on the bus).

2. Physical Exam Form – needed if camper has ongoing or health issues that require specialized or continuous care.

Please send to the Brooklyn Center Service Center four weeks prior to camp session (except Camp Northwoods – Physical Exam Form (if needed) must be in hand to get on the bus).

PLEASE NOTE: *Minnesota Youth Camp Rules state that if the health form identifies health problems (such as asthma or other respiratory disorders, allergies, blood disorders like hemophilia, or any chronic illnesses like cancer) or activity limitations, a physical examination performed by a licensed physician within one year before admission to the camp – including instructions relative to the limitation of the camper's participation in camp activities and/or medication requirements – is necessary.*

3. Billing statement with final payment

- Please return white copy of confirmation/billing statement with your final payment.

Please send to the Brooklyn Center Service Center four weeks prior to camp session.

4. Camper Information Form – all campers must have

5. Medication Information Form – needed if camper will be bringing medications to camp (prescription or over the counter, including vitamins). To be completed by parent/guardian.
