

OPENING DAY PROCEDURES

Plan to arrive between 2-3:30 p.m. on the first day of your camper's session. **Please note that the camp gate will NOT OPEN until 2 p.m.** Staff will be working hard to get ready for the session until that time. Once you arrive in camp, you will be directed where to go. You will be asked to do the following:

- Let us know in writing who can pick up your girl
- Help to get luggage to unit or drop off point
- Meet your camper's counselor and other staff
- Have camper complete a lice check and check in with the health staff to review health history and turn in any medications
- Turn in money and cookie credits at the camp store

The entire process lasts approximately one hour. Please note: no smoking or pets are allowed on camp property. Thank you for your cooperation.

DEPARTURE

Please plan to pick up your camper between 2-4 p.m. on the closing day of her session. Campers will be ready to go once you arrive. They will have luggage by the parking lot. Pick up should take a matter of minutes. You will be asked to officially check your camper out by signing the checkout report. You will receive all medications and any remaining camp store money at this time. Parents/guardians or others designated to pick up a camper should have photo ID available. If you are unable to pick up your camper by 4 p.m., please let us know when you drop her off. We can accommodate girls at camp for late pickups if necessary.

MAIL

Everyone loves to get mail at camp! Please write to your camper frequently during her stay at camp. Happy mail (not worrisome news or information on what she is missing out on) is the best type of mail to send. If you send a lot of mail at once and do not want your camper to get it all at the same time, just note the day you want it delivered on the envelope. Make sure to include a return address in case we get mail after the camper leaves camp! Do not send food to your camper. It attracts bugs and other critters. If a camper receives treats, they will be kept in the kitchen until departure. Mail should be addressed as follows:
