STEM

10,463 STEM badges were earned, including badges for coding, skilled trades like engineering and construction, space science, citizen science, and more.

CIVIC ENGAGEMENT

200 youth attended Girl Scout Day at the Capitol developing their advocacy skills, meeting their representatives, and seeing why their voice matters. GSRV also launched a first-of-it's kind Ready Set Vote! patch program with the MN Secretary of State to inspire older Girl Scouts to prepare/pre-register to vote.

ENTREPRENEURSHIP

75% of Girl Scouts learned critical business skills like goal setting and money management by participating in the Cookie Program earning \$3.4 million for their troops.

LEADERSHIP

149 Girl Scouts earned their Silver or Gold Awards by **creating sustainable projects with big community impact.**

COMMUNITY AND CULTURE

Over 1,400 youth joined Black, Indigenous, and People of Color (BIPOC) specific troops in 2023. Girl Scouts offers numerous cultural exploration programs to help kids learn about and celebrate difference cultures and communities.

OUTDOORS

12,324 badges were earned for outdoor programs, allowing Girl Scouts **develop confidence**, **try new things**, **and explore the world around them.** 1,900 kids made unforgettable memories at Girl Scout Camp.


