State-Specific Data Privacy Information

Girl Scouts River Valleys serves customers in Minnesota, Wisconsin, and Iowa.

Nonprofit organizations, including Girl Scouts River Valleys, are NOT exempt from the data privacy laws of **Minnesota**, **Wisconsin**, and **Iowa**.

Regardless of your state of residency, Girl Scouts River Valleys and Girl Scouts of the USA honors the following rights with respect to Personal Data collected from you when you visit our Sites:

- **Confirm** whether GSUSA is processing your Personal Data and, if so, **access** that Personal Data.
- **Rectify/correct** any inaccuracies in your Personal Data.
- Ask us to **delete** any of your Personal Data that is stored in our systems.
- **Obtain a copy** of the Personal Data we have for you in a format that allows you to transmit it to another data controller (also known as the "**Right to Data Portability**").
- **Opt out** of having your Personal Data processed for purposes of targeted advertising.

In addition to the rights described above, **Minnesota** residents have the **Right to Obtain a list of the third parties** with which we may disclose customers' Personal Data.

While we are not currently subject to the data protection laws that provide rights to residents of other U.S. states, we continue to monitor the privacy law landscape and, when necessary, will update our practices and this Notice to remain in compliance with applicable laws.
