  - All proceeds from the Cookie Program stay local!




### Cookie Information














# Cookie Central - Your destination for all things cookies!

- View details on rewards, how to use Cookie Credits, & more!






















### Ways to Sell Cookies

- Business to Business Sales (B2B)



# Parent/Guardian Support = Troop Success!

Simple ways that parents can support the troop:

- 1. Ask Girl Scout(s) about their goals, rewards, and how they want to sell
  - Review the <u>Family Entrepreneur Pin</u> guidelines for goal setting tips
- 2. Volunteer to support cookie booths & review our Cookie Booth Policy
- 3. Get familiar with Digital Cookie resources to learn the system: <u>Digital Cookie Help Center for Girl Scouts and Families</u>
- 4. Turn in money to the Troop Cookie Manager weekly and keep all receipts

### Finances


- All cookies are \$6 per package
  - Cash/checks (payable to Girl Scouts, Digital Cookie online/mobile payments
- Turn in cookie money weekly
- Families are responsible for cookies not returned to the troop by the Family Return Date
- Troop is responsible for leftover inventory at end of sale\*

\*Reach out to your Troop Volunteers if you have too much extra cookie inventory!

    - Download the Digital Cookie Mobile App to accept credit card/Venmo/PayPal payments for in-person sales
