school system.





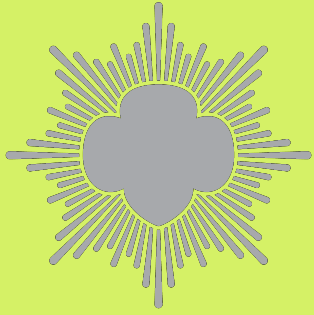


Zhara C.

drugs.



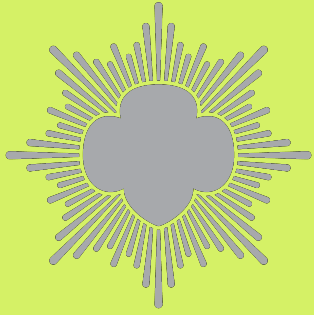

round.





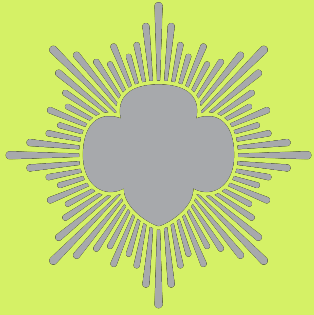
Brigid L.

Made fostering cats more accessible by designing, building, and distributing innovative cat trees with the local animal shelter.







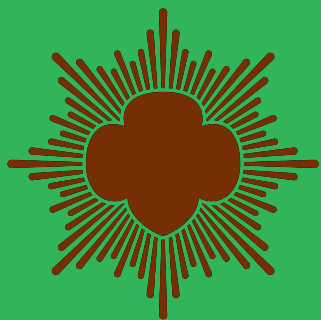

outdoors.







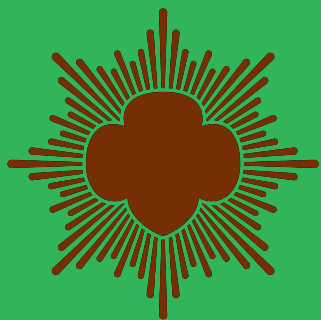
## Troop 47933

species.





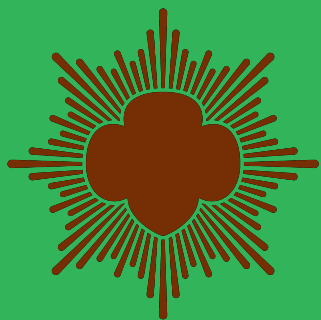


Troop 57795
