

Camp Lakamaga *Scandia, MN*

Rental Itinerary



Enjoy a Winter Wonderland at Camp Lakamaga. We have December and January rental options open for Troops. Enjoy the beauty of Lakamaga in the Winter and stay in a cozy warm (heated) cabin with your troop.

Meals*: Cook as a troop in your cabin's kitchen or work on your outdoor cooking skills and cook over the campfire by your cabin. Try these [campfire meal suggestions](#) (from GSMT/WY Council).

Suggested itinerary:

Friday Night

- After school drive to Camp Lakamaga- about a 45 min drive north of the metro
- Have Scouts eat before they are dropped off or stop for a quick meal on the way
- Check into your cabin get settled in for the evening- sunset will be around 4:30PM
- Bring board or card games from home and snack on some popcorn and play games as a troop

Pro tip for Troop Leaders-if you stack the provided sleeping mats 2 mats high you can use a twin sheet (from home) to hold them together and your back will thank you in the morning.

Saturday Morning

- Wake up in your cabin to the sounds of nature – or your early riser scouts!

Pro tip-All GS Cabins with kitchens have a coffee maker. Bring your own filters/coffee/creamers.

Saturday Daytime

Option A

Focus on Nature

- Work on Outdoor skill badges or an Outdoor Journey*, go hiking at camp, observe nature at camp- deer, birds, and look for animal tracks in the snow/mud. Use GSRV's snowshoes or cross country skis (need 5 inches of snowpack) and explore the camp.
- Schedule a visit to the [Wildlife Science Center](#) in Stacy- they have Scout programs available.

Option B

Focus on History

- Visit [Gammelgarden museum](#) in Scandia and learn about early Swedish Immigrants to MN
- Check out one of [GSRV's Historic GS Uniform kits](#) (from St P or BC) and bring it with you to camp and have your troop look at- and try on real GS uniforms from the past.

Saturday Night

- Sit out by the campfire and sing songs, roast marshmallows and watch the stars!

Sunday Morning

- Eat breakfast at Camp, clean up your site, pack up your cars and Scouts and head home.

* Troops are responsible for providing/bring up from home all their own meals/snacks, Art/badge supplies, and scheduling and paying for any field/troop trips. Kitchens come stocked with pots/pans and dishes
